- Write your "Selected Goal or Target" and "Essay Title" in the template.

1) Introduction	Describe briefly what you will be discussing in this essay.	
2) Explain the challenges (Body 1)	Explain clearly and in detail the challenges facing the region where you live or the community to which you belong. Present examples of the challenges, citing sources of evidence. Do not include an explanation of the SDGs or the selected targets themselves.	
3) Propose your solution (Body 2)	Introduce your solution and discuss how it addresses the challenge presented in 2).	
4) Conclusion	Summarize this entire essay by reflecting on what you wrote in your "Introduction."	
5) References	List any references, documents, websites, etc. that you have cited. You do not need to follow a specific style guide, but please present the list of references in a consistent manner. For an example of a consistent citation style, you may refer to APA Style (https://apastyle.apa.org/style-grammar-guidelines/references). Note that points will not be deducted for not following this style.
